A. Sharon & Ron DeCooman – Rural farm featuring 1200 registered cultivars, many for sale. Emphasis on tall, large flowered daylilies. Many newer varieties by Reed, Davisson, Gossard, Murphy, Holmes, and Bachman. Extensive hybridizing program has produced thousands of seedlings on display in open fields. AHS member.



D. Linda & David Spahr – Classic country garden surrounding a white farm house at a bend in the road. 800+ daylilies (old and new) mixed with hostas, perennials, and annuals. Many double cultivars, as well as numerous tall and late bloomers. AHS member.

B. Mike & Denise Anders – Nearly 2000 registered cultivars and seedlings on a half-acre city lot. Mostly large-flowering classic forms. Substantial collection of cultivars by Moldovan, Woodhall, and Valente. Also features numerous hostas and a wide collection of garden art. AHS member.

F. McClelland's Daylilies (Keith & Becky McClelland) - Over 500 cultivars, older and newer, planted in raised beds creating the visual impact of a sea of color across a one-acre garden that includes about 150 hostas. Emphasis on extra large spiders and doubles, very early through very late bloomers, many for sale. AHS member. Public restroom.



C. Perennial Plant Peddler (Ann & George Brickner) – Over 1300 registered cultivars and seedlings in AHS Display Garden, 900 for sale. All sizes, shapes, and forms. Numerous newly registered daylilies. Extensive display gardens also include 200 hostas, 200 irises, and well over 1000 other perennials. AHS member.

E. Richard & Robin Hopkins -- Over 200 registered daylilies in several beds as a "beginner collection" located in a historic south-end neighborhood. An assortment of hostas as well as various perennials and annuals surround the Victorian house and original carriage house which were built in 1874. Water features, garden art, and a small chicken coop blend with the numerous plants. AHS member.

G. Rick & Barb Kidwell— Over 650 registered daylilies in numerous beds display a profusion of colors and shapes. Several beds of evaluation plants from amateur hybridizing provide additional character. Landscaping also includes fountains, garden art, and several unique trees. AHS member.



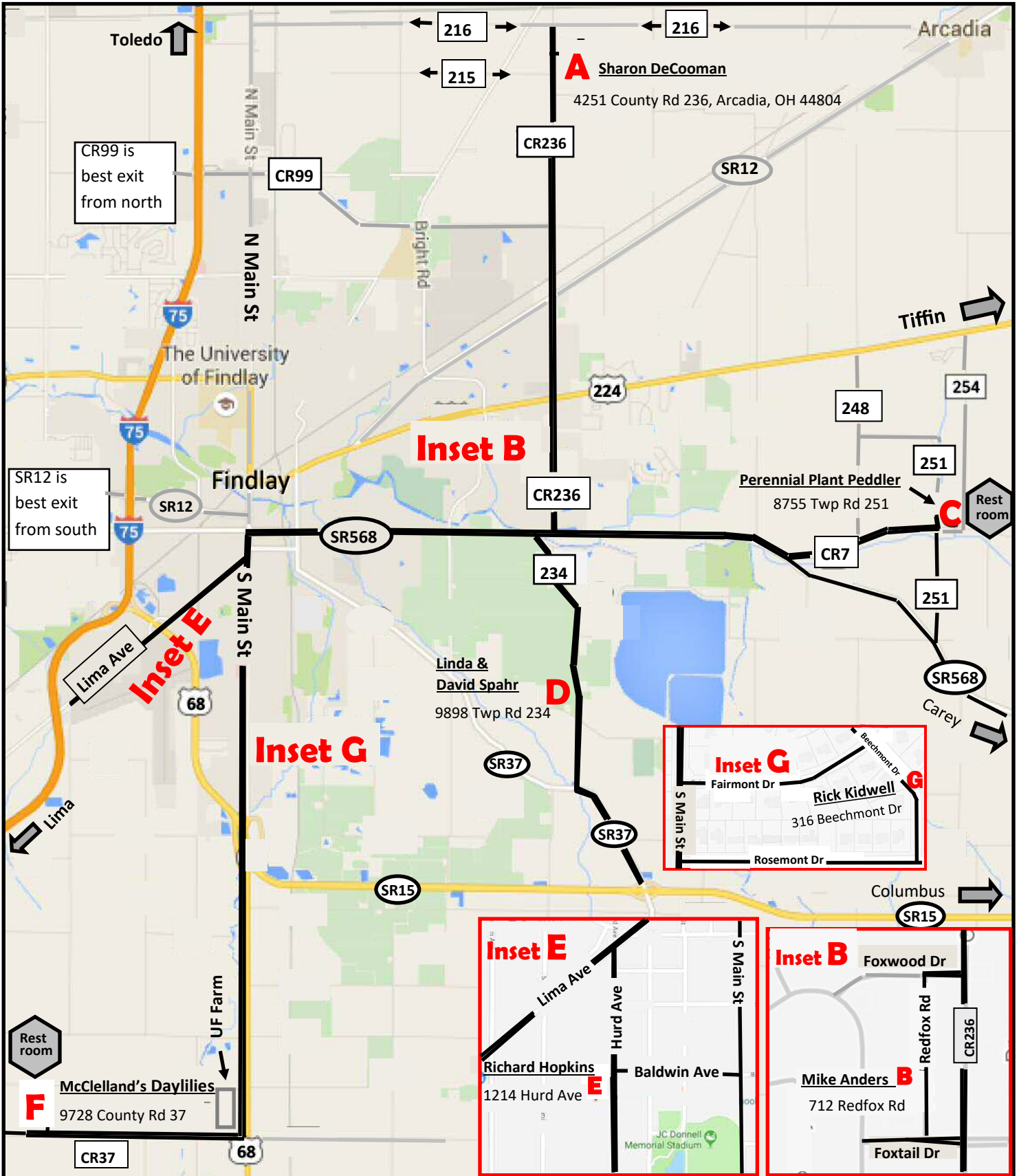
